**Clinic News** There have been several confirmed cases of the flu throughout all grades. In addition to the flu, we also have a stomach virus circulating. It is not too late to get the flu shot. Please keep your child home if they have a temperature of 100 F or higher, vomiting or diarrhea. They may return when they are fever free, (without fever reducing medication), no vomiting or diarrhea for 24 hours. Please remind your children the importance of frequent hand washing. **Re-enrollment 2020-2021 School Year** Re-enrollment for the 2020-2021 school year began on February 3rd. • Any family who enrolls by February 17 will pay a reduced enrollment fee of \$65 per student. After February 17, the enrollment fee will increase to \$100 per student.

- Families who enroll by March 15 will receive TWO dress down passes for each student in the family.
- Families who enroll by April 15 will receive one dress down pass for each child in the family.
- Students in the grade level with the highest percentage of re-enrolled students by May 15 will be entered into a drawing for a \$100 gift card from Flynn and O'Hara.
- As a reminder, the deadline for the Round One of financial aid is March 1.
